Family Resources for Student Meals and Food During the Corona Closure

Provincetown Schools will operate a *Grab & Go* drive-thru food collection/pick up that limits participant interaction and proximity to other participants. This is free of charge to all families per student enrolled. We have put together a list of over 16 foods that should provide your child 3 meals per day over a 4 day period. Items or procedures may change over the weeks ahead, but we'll adjust as needed moving forward. Starting Tuesday, March 17th, we will be offering an introductory bag with over 30 items to every student/family that is interested in participating with a pick up window **between 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm**. Our distribution center is located at the door of the gymnasium in the Grace Hall parking lot and will be open for the same 2 hour window every **TUESDAY** and **FRIDAY** thereafter. Students/families may pick up both days per week.

Send a TEXT MESSAGE (no calls please) to 619-204-4950, Chef Andrew, with your FAMILY NAME and STUDENT NAME/S if interested in participating to help organize food supply efforts. If your family is having trouble picking up, mention so in your text message. It is important to please stay inside your car and we will address you through your car window. Contents will be placed inside your car trunk for you.

Food For Children- On Thursday March 19th 10am-12pm food will be available for pick up or delivery. Please call 508-487-1558 x 203 by Wednesday March 18th at noon to reserve your bag. Leave family name, number of children, allergies or dietary restriction and address for delivery if needed. Delivery only available in Truro. Going forward food will be available every Tuesday 10am -12pm. Please call by 12pm the Friday before to reserve. Please pull up to the side door of the cafeteria and remain in your vehicle. Bags of food will be placed in your trunk. Once you have received your delivery please promptly exit the parking lot allowing for a quick, efficient process. Available to Truro children 3-18 years old.

In addition to **Wellfleet Elementary** (see below) there is a community food program being run by volunteers and the good people of **Fox and Crow Cafe** on Commercial St. Freshly made breakfasts and lunches are available to ANYONE in need, not just students. The "Grab and Go" hours are **8:00 to 10:00 AM Monday thru Saturday**. Daily updates and menus are posted on their <u>Facebook page</u>. This is a community funded, volunteer run program. Please remember to maintain a safe distance from others, especially at the outdoor bar. If you prefer to stay in your car, pull up and toot the horn, they'll run food out to you.

Nauset Food Services Program provides a "Grab-and-Go" service for students in order to offer free breakfast and lunch to all families. This program is being offered for children, eighteen years of age and under, by providing meals that would typically be provided during the school day. Families will be allowed to pick up meals for their own children on a daily basis. There will be four locations for this "Grab-and-Go" food program. Parents may pick up meals at ANY one of the four locations including:

- Eddy Elementary School Brewster (2298 Main Street drive around to the back parking lot and pick up will be behind the school)
- Orleans Elementary School Orleans (46 Eldredge Park Way at the front of the school)
- Eastham Elementary School Eastham (200 Schoolhouse Rd. enter the back parking lot where parent drop-off occurs)
- Wellfleet Elementary School Wellfleet (100 Lawrence Rd. drive into the first parking lot entrance and pick-up will be by the cafeteria door)

The "Grab-and-Go" meals will be available for pick-up from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM daily, Monday through Friday. When you drive up to the site, please remain in your vehicle and tell the food service worker how many children you have. Once the meals have been "delivered" to you, we ask that you exit the line promptly so as to minimize social contact and to allow others to avail themselves of this service. These meals are free and all food will be a "bagged breakfast" and a "bagged lunch" and will be allergy-aware. The meals provided will be compliant with the USDA School Lunch Guidelines.

The Monomoy Regional School District Food Services Department will be offering grab-and-go meal service in order to provide both free breakfast and lunch to all students, beginning March 20, 2020. This program is being offered for children, 18 years of age and under, by providing meals that would typically be provided during the

school day. Families will be able to pick up both meals at the same time for their children on a daily basis.

There will be two drive-through locations for the grab-and-go food program. **The meals** will be brought to the car - please remain in the vehicle. Parents and caregivers may pick up the packaged breakfast and lunch together at either location:

- Monomoy Regional Middle School, 425 Crowell Road, Chatham (drive around the back loop and pull up by the cafeteria door on the right)
- Monomoy Regional High School, 75 Oak St., Harwich (drive around the back of the building and pull up by the community entrance doors)

The grab-and-go meals will be available for pick-up from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. daily, Monday through Friday. As drivers pull up, they should **remain in the vehicle** and tell the food services worker how many children they have. After receiving the meals, drivers are asked to exit the line promptly to minimize social contact and allow expedient delivery to others.

You may go to any school in the district. Choose the closest and most convenient school for you. (Baker, Wixon, Small, Station Avenue, Mattacheese and D-Y High School)

Note: We are working with some other organizations to provide additional food to families at these same pick up sites once a week. More information will be forthcoming as soon as it is available.
