C.A.R.P. WEEKLY OUTLINE & ADVENTURE EXAMPLES:

TUESDAY: HIKING & BEACH DAYS

Each week will focus on a morning hike & afternoon at the beach in a different town. Campers should bring any beach gear they would like to use at the beach- surf/ boogie/ skimboards, beach chairs, sun umbrellas, etc.
