Charter School Advocacy! As the new calendar year begins, our state lawmakers are preparing to turn their attention to the next fiscal year. In the coming weeks and months, lawmakers will develop proposals for the Commonwealth’s Fiscal Year 2027 budget, determining how to allocate state tax revenue to meet the many needs of Massachusetts residents. Over recent months, we’ve been speaking out against proposed bills that would hurt charter public schools. While continuing to fight against those bills, next month, we’ll raise our voices to ask our lawmakers to prioritize fair funding for all students.



Massachusetts Charter Public Schools Fair Funding Week 2026 will take place from Monday, February 2nd to Friday, February 6th.

Did you know that kids attending charter public schools receive less funding for their school buildings than kids attending traditional public schools? As lawmakers get ready to build our state’s budget for the next year, we have an opportunity to change that – ensuring all of our kids and our schools are funded fairly!

## We all need time to re-adjust

The first days back can feel bumpy - not because something is wrong, but because routines, expectations, and social & academic demands return **all at once**. What you are seeing is often re-entry, not regression or backsliding



## Mindset

Re-entry is not a test of how well a break went.

It is a transition - and transitions are hard for developing brains.
