**Executive Director Search Committee Update** - The hiring committee would like to update the community as to the progress of the Executive Director's search:

- The Director Search Committee, consisting of CCLCS Board members, school staff and parent/guardian representatives, originally received 15 applications by the closing date of 12/31/21.
- Applicants were narrowed down to 5 semi-finalists.
- Interviews were scheduled with all 5.
- Interviews were held with 4, as one individual withdrew his application.
- The committee has identified 2 finalists for the position.
- Visit days for the finalists, including stakeholder meetings, are scheduled for Wednesday, February 9th (Catherine O'Leary) and Thursday, February 10th (Peter Schutzler).

**8 ELA** - Benchmark Essay scores are posted, and essays will be handed back tomorrow. A 70% or below indicates that students should get teacher support for the next essay. 70-80% means students should share a draft with a teacher for support. An 80% and above means students are clear to peer-edit and use revision check lists for essays from here on out! We will finish *Lord of the Flies* next week and will do an essay about a symbol or allegory in the book after the break.

## **Community Notes**

The Wilkens Family Dental Hygiene Clinic at Cape Cod Community College will provide free examinations and cleanings for children ages 3 to 17, with appointments available during February vacation week. The dental care at the clinic will be provided by the college's Dental Hygiene program students, under the supervision of licensed dental hygienists and dentists.

Officials with the college said that children who are scheduled for exams during the vacation week will be provided with an exam, cleaning, fluoride treatment and toothbrush instruction at no cost to the family. A parent or legal guardian must be present for the appointment.
