7th Grade

The Holocaust project was assigned in class today. For this project, students will be researching individuals who are "Righteous Among the Nations," a title bestowed by Yad Vashem in Israel. These individuals are people who risked their lives to save Jews during the Holocaust. The goal of this project is to understand the critical role played by those who risked their lives to save others during the Holocaust and to understand the difference that an individual can make in society.

The first project check in is due on Monday, December 6 and the second project check in is on Friday December 10. The complete project is due on Friday, December 17 (please remember that 10 points are taken off for late projects). An extensive project explanation is posted on Google Classroom along with a number of resources. Please note that students must use at least one source that is not a web site. Articles found in online journals or newspapers are fine and books are encouraged. If you need a particular book, it's a good idea to contact your local library soon since students will be "competing" for the same resources. Please let me know if you have any questions about the project itself of the subject matter.

You are invited to view a student-curated exhibition of Civil Rights Era photographs by Grammy Award winner Rowland Scherman. Students and teachers will be on hand to lead tours of the collection and members of the public are invited to contribute to the school's oral history project by recording their own stories about the Civil Rights Movement and modern-day social justice issues.

In 2020, the Cape Cod Lighthouse Charter School received a donation of more than 50 photographs from renowned photographer Rowland Scherman. The collection documents the people, places and events of America's Civil Rights Movement. From Martin Luther King's iconic *I Have a Dream Speech* and the March on Washington to Arthur Ashe's groundbreaking tennis prowess, to artists like Langston Hughes and Sidney Poitier, Scherman captured the essence of the 1960s.
