




What is Portvisory?

We meet once a month to:


- Share more about yourself as a person

Why do we do it?



To **make a binder** full of materials **to remember the cool stuff you do at CCLCS**, and to **see how you grow as both a student and a person over your time here!**

4. Turn cool experiences into memories that really teach you something!




Start with HELLO
